








### ONWARDS FLOWS STORY

When the mighty docks fell silent, change rode in on the financial markets: up sprung the skyscrapers of Canary Wharf, igniting redevelopment across the district.











The latest wave of regeneration builds on the wildly successful foundations of the 2012 Olympic Games, transforming not only Stratford but Hackney Wick, Bow Creek and Poplar, Oxbow's home. Design studios, digital start-ups and tech labs all flocked here, leading to the densest concentration of artists and creative professionals in Europe.

Today, East London enjoys an unrivalled level of investment, reimagined as a key destination for culture, sport, business and education. There's so much to come – and Oxbow is in the heart of it all.

Every resident can use the on-site gym. Open from 6am every day, it's fitted with state-of-the-art Technogym equipment.








### **TASTE** SOMETHING **DIFFERENT**






Oxbow is in the heart of London's most creative quarter. Explore the sculpture park and street art at Trinity Buoy Wharf, or head up to Theatre Royal Stratford East for a ground-breaking play or comedy slam. Over by Bartlett Park, Poplar Union runs a diverse programme of events, from spoken-word performances to dance shows and art classes. For live entertainment and shows, visit the Grade II listed venue, Troxy.









### ROOM BREATHE



Walk through the stunning roof garden at Crossrail Place, an artificial island in West India Docks, or meet friends at Victoria Park, just 17 minutes away by bike. Enjoy a lazy cruise across the boating lake – or wild time out at All Points East, a 10-day summer festival.

Just a short hop south from Oxbow lies Bow Creek Ecology Park, a former ironworks, shipyard and coal wharf, now an award-winning wildlife haven, and neighbouring East India Dock Basin, a sanctuary teeming with birds and wildflower meadows, offering panoramic river views.



### ENDORPHIN





London's industrial past.




Living and dining areas feature wood effect flooring leading to your private balcony, with underfloor heating throughout the apartment.
